Please complete SY24-25 enrollment by following three steps:

- 1. Complete the DCPS enrollment packet using <u>online enrollment</u> or <u>paper forms</u>.
- 2. Gather and attach supporting documents.
- 3. Submit the packet and supporting documents to your student's school enrollment team.

Each year, DC Public Schools (DCPS) students participate in assessments designed to measure and evaluate their learning. In addition to grades and feedback from educators, this information provides critical context around your child's academic growth. Our students in grades $3^{rd} - 5^{th}$ will begin taking their DC CAPE test on April 9th.

At the school level, DCPS utilizes these assessment results to improve outcomes for scholars. At the district level, these data guide decisions such as educator training and resource allocation to ensure comprehensive support for all students.

"Self-Dismissal" and Sibling Pickup Permission Form

All students in grades *PK 3 through 5* must have a signed permission form on file to walk or take public transportation home alone or with a sibling. No student will be allowed to leave school alone or with a sibling until the attached form has been signed and returned to the main office.

This form is only required for students who are walking or taking public transportation home without their parent, guardian, or another adult who is authorized by you to pick them up. Please return a separate signed form for each of your children.

Students will not be allowed to walk home at dismissal if this form is not returned.
