It's Time for DC CAPE for 3rd – 5th Grades

The District of Columbia Comprehensive Assessments of Progress in Education (DC CAPE) is the District's general statewide assessment system, which includes assessments in English language arts/literacy (ELA), mathematics and science. Together, these assessments create a comprehensive system that provides important information on students' progress and proficiency relative to DC's educational standards. Our students in 3rd – 5th will begin testing April 7th and run through May 15th.

How you can help:

- Make sure your student arrives on time by 9am. If student is late, they will not be able to test and a make-up day will be required.
- Help ensure your student gets a good night sleep each night, eat breakfast at home or arrive at school at 8:45am.
- Talk to your student about the test and encourage them to do their best!

Kids Ride Free Metro/Bus Cards

If you have a card from last school year, please request a new one. The ones from last school year will expire at the end of September. The Kids Ride Free program allows students enrolled in DC Public Schools, DC Charter Schools, and DC private/parochial schools to receive a KRF SmarTrip card for free travel to and from school and school-related activities within the District of Columbia, using Metrorail, Metrobus or the DC Circulator. Please contact the main office (202-939-5390) if your student needs a Kids Ride Free card for the new school year for the bus or metro. **Reminder that these cards are for student use ONLY!!**

Immunization Forms 📝📄

If you have not turned in your health forms, please do so right away! Health physicals and oral health assessments are required annually. Students also must be current with their immunizations to attend school. As outlined below, a series of medical forms should be turned in to the school as part of the enrollment process, and any updated forms throughout the school year should be submitted to the school nurse.
